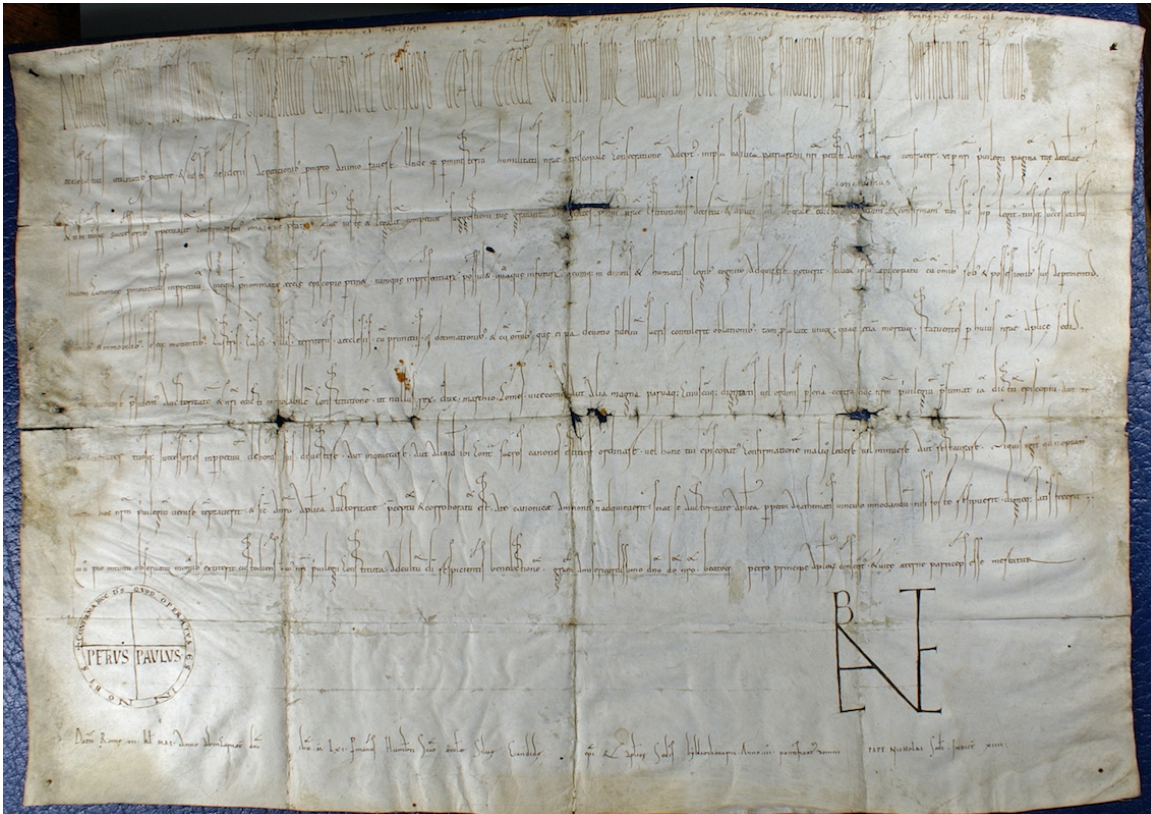


*A provisional checklist of*  
papal letters and privileges for recipients in Anglo-Saxon England



*Privilege granted by Pope Nicholas II to Giso, newly consecrated bishop of Wells, at Rome, on 25 April 1061. The original letter survives among the muniments at Wells cathedral.*

In May 1839 John Mitchell Kemble apprised Jacob Grimm of his intention to compile 'a complete collection of all the Papal Bulls relating to England from 600 to 1060'. Alas, the project never came to fruition. The list provided below is a provisional register of papal letters relating to Anglo-Saxon England. It will be developed and taken further as time allows.
